**In summary:**

Club will be open for children from Year 1 up to Year 6

- We will look at the possibility of opening up club to children in Reception in the spring term
- Numbers will be limited at 20, therefore children must be booked into club beforehand by contacting the school office
- The same high standards of behaviour that are expected within school time, will be expected in club
- All children must be picked up at the end of club, no children will be allowed to walk home and,
- Children will now be picked up from the ramp into the school hall at the back of school. This is the same entrance that children use for breakfast club.

We have listened, and as well as opening up to more Year groups we have also extended timings. To that end, in order to cover costs, we have had to adjust prices accordingly.
