### Science and Technology

We will be studying two science topics over this term, during which we will explore the range of concepts and vocabulary linked to each and build up to a full investigation.

### Health and Wellbeing (PE and PSE)

PSE: We will be building our one-page profiles and exploring what we each need as individuals in order to learn effectively.

### Humanities (History, Geography and RE)

- An in depth look at the history of 'magic' in Wales, the UK and wider world

### Languages, Literacy and Communication

We will be covering 2 genres of writing this term:

- Poetry - imaginative work building our knowledge of figurative language and exciting vocabulary
- Non-Chronological Report - researching, compiling and organising information effectively, developing sentence structure for effect

Children will also have opportunities to build on their oracy and reading skills through a range of contexts

### Cymraeg

We will be recapping the language on the conversation mats this first half term, followed by and introduction to third person description.

### Expressive Arts

Art - Explore and experiment with a variety of materials and styles based on a study of Van Gogh's Starry Night

Music - Build appraisal knowledge and skills, exploring a range of music by composer John Williams. Build up to creating own musical pieces using tuned and untuned instruments.
