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Snack

We are now charging for snack a different way. We keep a daily log of who has taken snack each day and rather than charging accounts each half term, we will now be taking weekly payments for exactly what has been taken that week with snack costing 20p per day. It is still preferred that snack is paid half termly but can now also be paid weekly if you wish.

Headlice

Unfortunately, the subject of headlice remains a problem. **Many children are being sent to school clearly needing treatment.** This can be very uncomfortable and distressing for the child. Please take time over the weekend to check your child's hair. Correct treatments for headlice can be obtained free on prescription from your doctor or can be purchased at local supermarkets and chemists. It is very important the treatment is repeated **AGAIN** seven days later.

As the weather is getting warmer, it is even more important that children bring a bottle into school with them. May we also remind you that in line with our healthy schools policy, only still, unflavoured water may be brought in from home.

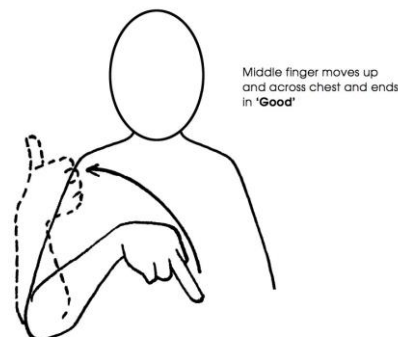
