### Dosbarth Criccieth Parents Evening

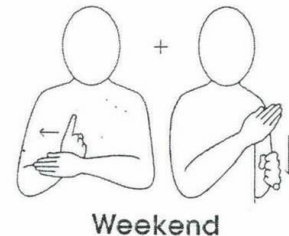

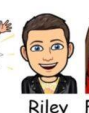
