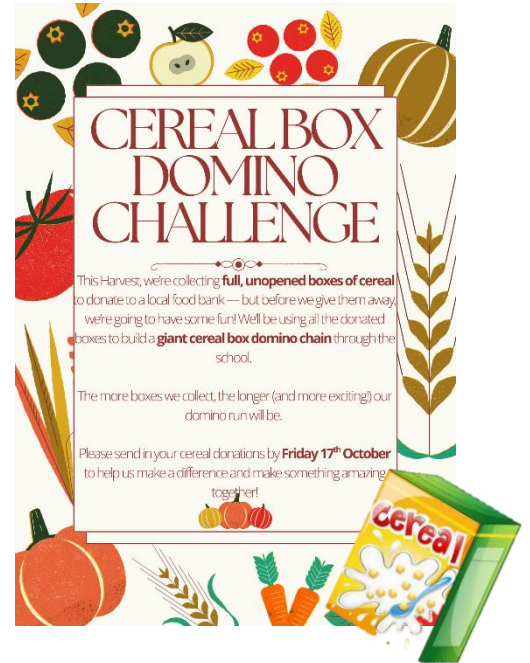

Come and join in the spooky fun! There will be sweets, crisps and drinks available to buy, and prizes for the best groovy dancing.

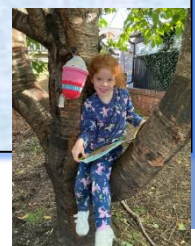
