Flying Start



Applications are now open for January's intake.

You will need to live at a Wrexham postcode and your child must turn 2 before the start of the term you are applying for.

You will need to complete the Flying Start 2-year-old Childcare Application Form. You can only apply once your child has reached 18 months of age.

Early Education

Applications are now open for January's intake.

Applications for spring term entry.

Children whose 3rd birthday falls between September 1 to December 31 will be eligible for a 10-hour funded place for the Spring and Summer term, from January until July.

Applications open from September 1st and you'll need to apply by October 23rd 2026 to be offered a place starting in spring term, January 2027.
